



## Family Recovery Court

### What is FRC?

Family Recovery Court (FRC) is a voluntary program designed to work with families who struggle with substance use and are involved with the child welfare system. The immediate goal of FRC is sobriety; however, the ultimate goal is for parents to regain custody of their child(ren).

### Mission

To ensure that parents who enter FRC transform into caregivers with the resources to provide safe, stable, homes for their child(ren) through the collaborative services of the court, treatment, and community.

### Who is Eligible?

You may be eligible for the Jefferson Family Recovery Court if:

- You struggle with alcohol or drug addiction
- You are involved with Child Protective Services and Family Court due to substance use
- You want to safely reunify or maintain custody of your children

### Services Provided

- Thorough treatment assessments
- Specialized Child Protective Services workers to help navigate through court
- Intensive case management
- Family interventions: parent-child relationships
- Housing
- Vocational training and life skills training
